Creating the Outer Shape/Placement Line:

1. Click on IQ Designer



2. Click on Shapes



3. Click on Closed Shapes



4. Select the Fancy Frame Shape (Row 1 Column 4)



5. Click OK

6. Click on Size

7. Change the H = 4.25" and the W = 2.25"



8. Click OK

9. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



10. Select the Double Run Icon



11. Change Color to Red

12. Click OK



13. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

14. Touch the Line

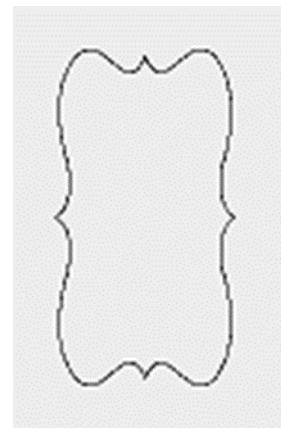
15. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory

(for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow Machines Memory



then click on Machine

16. Click Next



17. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

18. Click on Add

19. Click IQ Designer

20. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon



(For Destiny – Click on the pocket with the blue arrow)



21. Click on the Machines Memory

22. Select the design you just created

23. Click OK or Set depending on your machine

Creating the Tackdown Line:

1. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

2. Select the Double Run Icon

3. Change the Color to Yellow

4. Click OK

5. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

6. Touch the Outline

7. Click Next

8. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

9. Click on Add

Creating the Ovals:

1. Click on IQ Designer

2. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon



(For Destiny – Click on the pocket with the blue arrow)



3. Click on the Machines Memory

4. Select the Red Outer Shape that was previously created

5. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



6. Select the No Sew Icon



7. Click OK



8. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon



9. Touch the Line

10. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory

(for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow Machines Memory)



then click on Machine

11. Click on the Shapes Icon



12. Select the Oval Shape



(Row 3 Column 5)

13. Click OK

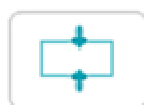
14. Click on Rotate

15. Rotate the Oval 90 Degrees to the Right

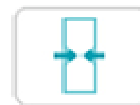
16. Click OK

17. Click on Size

18. Reduce the Size to H=.40"



and W=3.15"



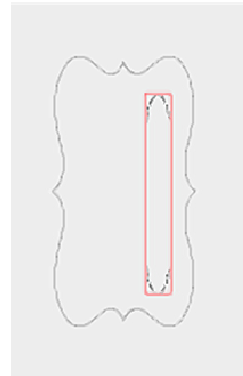
19. Use the arrows and move the Oval to the far right of the cord wrapper

20. Click OK

21. Click on Duplicate



22. Click on the Size



23. Using the arrows, move the copied Oval to the left side of the cord wrapper

24. Click OK

25. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

26. Select the Double Run Icon

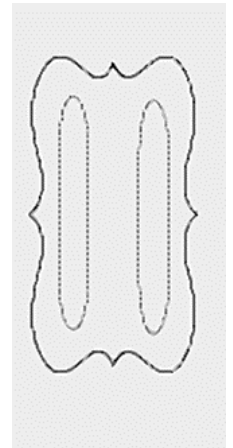


27. Change Color to Purple

28. Click OK

29. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

30. Touch Both Ovals



Creating the Circles for the Snaps:

1. Click on the Shapes Icon

2. Select the Circle  (Row 3 Column 1)

3. Click OK

4. Click Size

5. Reduce the Circle Proportionately to H=.40" and W=.40"



6. Use the arrows and move the Circle to the top of the cord wrapper



7. Click OK
8. Click on the Duplicate Icon
9. Click on Size
10. Use the arrows to move the copied circle to the bottom of the cord wrapper
11. Click OK
12. Click on the Line Region Property Icon
13. Select the Double Run Icon
14. Change Color to Green
15. Click OK
16. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon
17. Touch Both Circles
18. Click Next
19. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

20. Click Add
21. Click on IQ Designer

22. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon



(For Destiny – Click on the pocket with the blue arrow



23. Click on the Machines Memory
24. Select the Red Outline
25. Click OK or Set Depending on the machine



26. Click on the Line Region Property Icon
27. Select the Double Run Icon
28. Change the Color to Beige
29. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon
30. Touch the Outline
31. Click Next
32. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up
(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)
33. Click on Memory
34. Save the design to the Machine's Memory
35. Click Embroidery
36. You have just completed creating your Cord Wrapper – ENJOY 😊

Embroidering the Cord Wrapper:

1. Hoop a piece of No Show Water Soluble Stabilizer in the 5" x 7" Hoop
2. Thread the Machine with White Embroidery Thread on top and White Thread in the bobbin
3. Stitch Color 1 (Placement Line)
4. Lay a piece of Vinyl over the Placement Line. Tape in place
5. Stitch Color 2 (Tackdown Line)
6. Stitch Color 3 (The Circle for the Snaps)
7. Stitch Color 4 (The Ovals)
8. Remove the Hoop from Machine and Lay the hoop on top of a cutting mat and using a rotary cutter cut a slit through both ovals.
9. Turn the Hoop over to the back and Lay another piece of Vinyl – Right Side Out and Tape in Place
10. Attach hoop back on the Machine
11. Stitch out the Final Color – Color 5
12. Remove the Hoop from the Machine
13. Trim close to the stitching line
