



FLORAL COASTER INSTRUCTIONS



Another versatile Coaster set
Super Quick to Stitch
No hand sewing
Multiple sizes to make sets



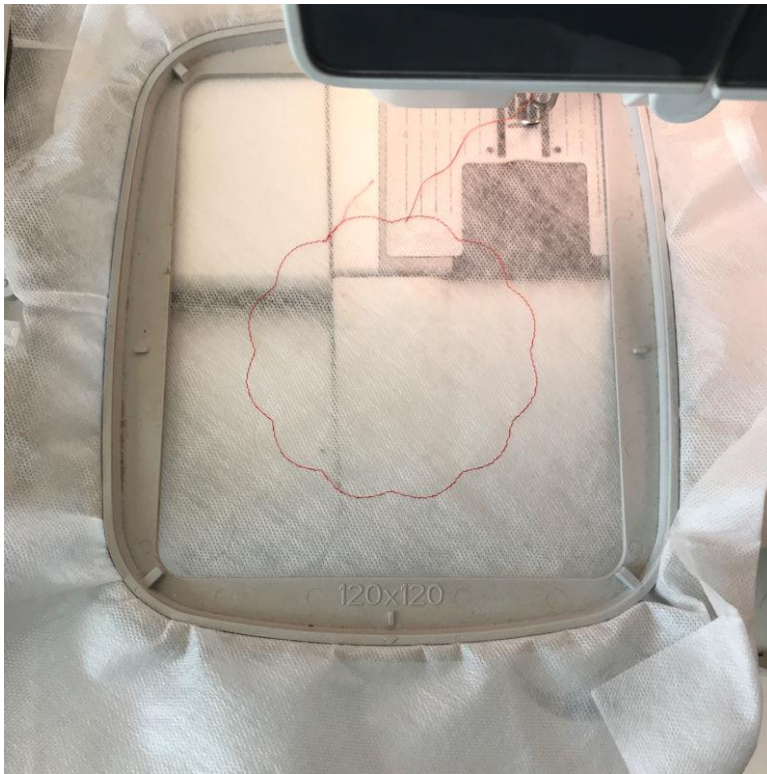
- This set includes the five floral designs in:
- Floral Design only 4x4
 - Coaster – Single Satin Stitch – 4x4
 - Coaster – Double Satin Stitch – 5x5 6x6 and 8x8
 - 'Blank' Coaster with inner quilting 4x4 5x5 6x6 and 8x8

MATERIALS

- Wash-away Stabiliser to fit hoop (fabric type – not Solvy)
- Iron on Interfacing **optional

	8x8	6x6	5x5	4x4
Inner Block (white)	7x7 inch	6x6 inch	5x5 inch	
Pellon/Batting	9 x 9-inch	7x7 inch	6x6 inch	5x5 inch
Outer Edge Fabric	9 x 9-inch	7x7 inch	6x6 inch	5x5 inch
Backing Fabric	9 x 9-inch	7x7 inch	6x6 inch	5x5 inch

EMBROIDERY 4x4 COASTER



Load design to your machine

Thread your machine with the Satin Stitch Frame color

Stitch Color 1 – Outline of Coaster



Place your
pellon/batting and
fabric piece over the
Guideline and stitch
Color 2 to attach



Stitch Color 3
Flower Design
Or
Quilting for Blank
Coaster

ADD BACKING



Remove hoop from Machine, and tape Backing Fabric to hoop

Wrong Side of Fabric facing Hoop

OR if you are comfortable with floating the backing, you can place the backing fabric under the hoop



Return hoop to Machine

Stitch Color 4 to attach the backing



Remove hoop from Machine

Cut away excess Fabric on FRONT and back of hoop



Return hoop to Machine

Stitch Color 5 which zig zags, and then completes the Satin Stitch

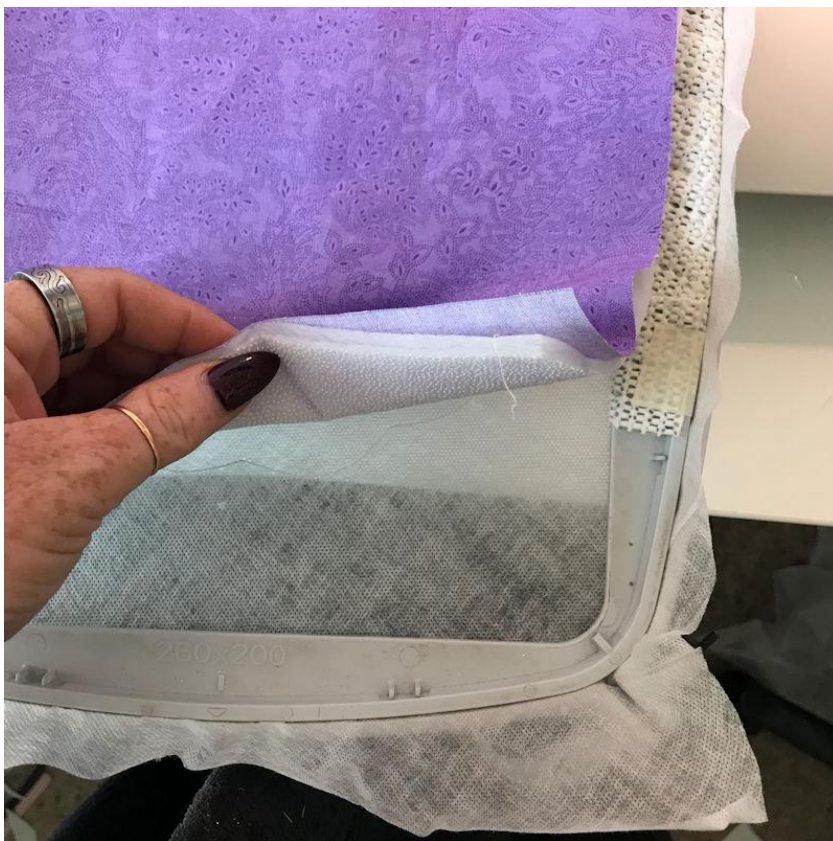
EMBROIDERY DOUBLE SATIN STITCH FRAMES 5X5 6X6 8X8



Load design to your machine

Thread your machine with the Background Frame color

Stitch Color 1 – Outline of Block



Place your pellow/batting and fabric piece over the Guideline



Stitch Color 2 to attach, and stitch the guideline for your inner fabric



TIP

If you have a dark fabric for the frame, cut out the centre square – this will stop the darker fabric showing thru the white

Skip this step if using light colored fabrics



Place your inner fabric over the guideline

Stitch Color 3 to attach



Stitch Color 4

Flower Design

Or

Quilting for Blank Coaster



Using sharp scissors,
cut away excess
fabric around the
inner frame



Stitch Color 5 – zig
zag inner frame



Change thread
back to the
Background Color

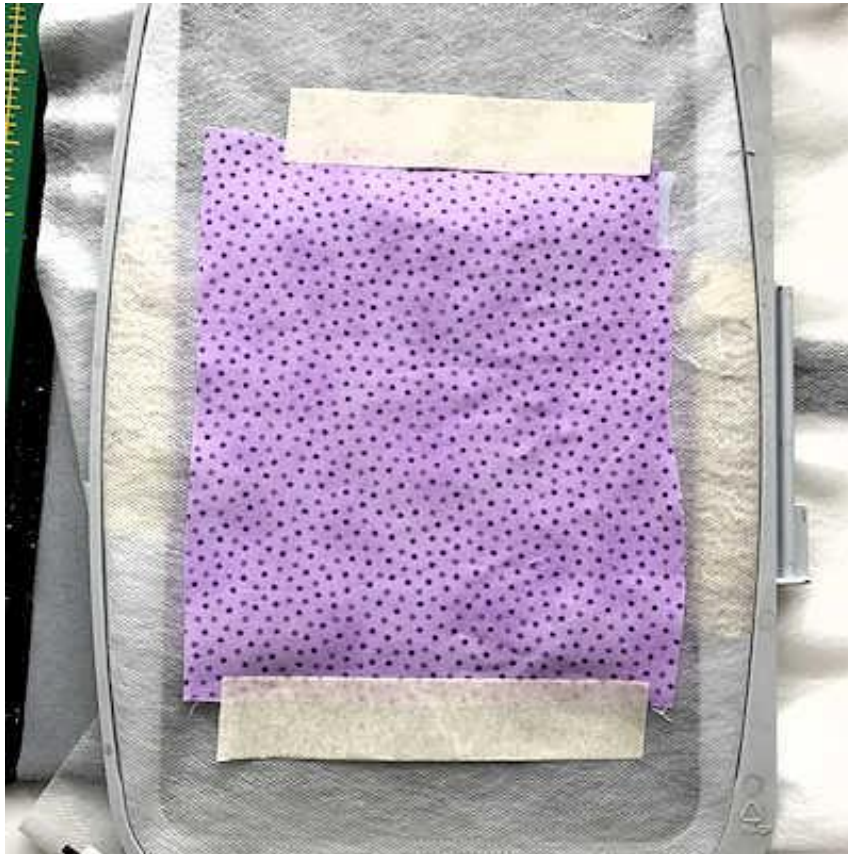
Stitch Color 6 which
stitches the outer
frame quilting



Change to thread
color for inner frame

Stitch Color 7 – Inner
Frame Satin Stitch

ADD BACKING



Remove hoop from Machine, and tape Backing Fabric to hoop

Wrong Side of Fabric facing Hoop

OR if you are comfortable with floating the backing, you can place the backing fabric under the hoop



Return hoop to Machine

Stitch Color 8 to attach the backing



Remove hoop from Machine

Cut away excess Fabric on FRONT and back of hoop



Return hoop to Machine

Stitch Color 9 which zig zags, and then completes the Satin Stitch

FINISHING



Remove from hoop

Cut away the
excess Stabiliser
around the edges

Use a Cotton Bud/Q
Tip and warm water
to dissolve any
stabiliser left on the
edges

VARIATIONS

I added the design to a Tea Towel (you could make a lovely set) – I like doing my towels this way, as you add the backing just like the Coasters, which gives a neat and tidy finish for your towels.



Back



You follow exactly the same instructions, the difference is in the first Stitch Color

- Hoop Water Soluble Stabiliser
- Stitch Color 1 – Placement Line
- Place your Towel over the hoop – aligning centre etc
- **STITCH COLOR 1 AGAIN** to attach to Towel
- Continue as per Coaster instructions

** I add pellow/wadding for tea towels – if you were using a bath towel, you could just place fabric only
